ENTRY DEADLINE:

ENTRY FEE:

Entry fee will be based on entries before scratches.

ENTRY PROCEDURE:

All entries will be done online through Direct Athletics (www.directathletics.com).

ENTRIES:

Unlimited entries within reason.

TIME SCHEDULE:

A finalized time schedule will be released on shortly after entries are received.

PACKET PICK-UP:

Packet pick-up will be available on the Track Level of Gordon Track.

SCRATCHES:

Will be accepted at packet pick-up

SAFETY:

AS PER NCAA REGULATIONS, NO HEADPHONES OR AUDIO DEVICES ARE ALLOWED ON THE INFIELD OR ON THE TRACK AT ANY TIME!

DRESSING/SHOWER FACILITIES:

Not Available

SPIKES:

- The use of 1/4" pyramid spikes will be strictly enforced.
- NO NEEDLE SPIKES OR CHRISTMAS TREE SPIKES ALLOWED.

- No permanent spiked shoes allowed.

PREFERRED LANES:

Sprint Straightaway Races	4-5-3-6-2-7-1-8
200m-400m	5-6-4-3-2-1

SCORING:

10, 8, 6, 4, 2, 1

COMPETITION WARM-UP:

No warming up will be allowed on the competition track starting 15 minutes prior to the start of competition and remain in effect until the completion of the competition. The straightaway will be open for warm-ups after the conclusion of the sprint dashes. Field Event warm-ups will be conducted per the NCAA Rules.

FIELD EVENT ADVANCEMENT PROCEDURE:

Field Events – 9 advance to final

Track Events – 8 advance to the final in the 60m and 60HH.

WEIGH-IN:

The implement area is located just left of the throws cage. All implements will be certified with officials prior to the start of each event. Please have your implements picked up after completion of the event.

RUNWAY MARKS:

White athletic tape may be used on the runways. Chalk and Cones are not permitted.

PARKING:

University Operations office may be charging for parking \$10.00/vehicle to park outside Gordon Track. There will be parking available on the backside of the Business School (\$6.00/vehicle). Team bus and van parking will be designated upon arrival.
