Like last year, there will be three divisions (based upon the 2016 attendance numbers from the NH Department of Education). A school can petition up to a higher division but not down.

The 44rd annual Middle School State Cross Country Championships will be held this year on Saturday, October 21, 2017 at both **Londonderry High School (Division I and II)** and **Coe-Brown Northwood Academy (Division III)**. Listed below are all the details of the meets.

GENERAL INFO FOR ALL RACES FOR ALL SITES

ENTRY PROCEDURE: You must read the instructions marked **Coaches Must Read** on Middle School web page where this document is posted. All entries must be completed on Direct Athletics by noon on **Friday - October 13, 2017**. Please delete anyone on your roster that is no longer on your team. If you have problems email Rick at rick@lancertiming.com. **SCHOOLS THAT MISS THE ABOVE DEADLINE WILL BE ASSESSED A LATE FEE OF \$25.**

SCORING: In the scoring races, the top 5 individuals will determine a team's score. Runners from incomplete teams will not be counted when the scoring is done. We are able to do this (the official way to score cross country) because the computer is doing the scoring for us. Coaches will not have to turn in any score sheets.

IT IS MANDATORY THAT ALL TEAM MEMBERS IN THE SCORING RACES HAVE THE SAME COLOR RACING TOPS.

RESULTS: Results will be posted after each race. However, paper copies of the results will not be given to coaches following the conclusion of the meet. All results will be posted on www.LancerTiming.com immediately following the last event.

INDIVIDUAL ELIGIBILITY: Any middle school student who is in 6th, 7th or 8th grade (**NO 5th or 9th GRADERS PLEASE**) who has not reached his or her 16th birthday by the day of the meet is eligible. For a possible waiver to this rule, please contact Larry Martin **BEFORE** race day. However, 5th graders will be allowed to run in the scoring championship races if they are part of their team's top 7 runners.

AWARDS: Team trophies will be presented to the winning team in each scoring race. Individual plaques will be given to the top 10 finishers in each scoring race. Custom patches will be presented to each finisher. Team medals will also be presented to the members of the top four teams in all scoring races. Medals will be given to the top 10 finishers in all non-scoring races.

DRESSING FACILITIES: Very limited, so please come changed and ready to run.

TEAMS: All athletes must represent the school they attend. No schools can combine together to form one team.

The weather would have to be very bad for us to even consider postponing a meet of this size!!! In over 40 years, this meet has **never** been cancelled. It has been held in the rain!!!

DIVISION III MEETS WILL BE HELD AT COE-BROWN NORTHWOOD ACADEMY

TIME: Meet starts at 11:30 am. **Please do not arrive before 9:30 am.**

COURSE: A wheeled 2 miles. The course is run on groomed wide trails, rugged single-track trail and ends on the track. A similar course is used for the Black Bear XC Invitational, and for the Southeast League Championship meet. The course can also be viewed at the Run To Fall 5k on September 10, 2017 or at the Black Bear Invitational (Middle School Race) on September 30, 2017.

RACES: We will be running 4 races, with each race having between 100 and 200 athletes. The championship races will be restricted to the top 7 runners from each team. All other athletes should go into the non-scoring races. Any number of athletes from a school can enter these non-scoring races. Individuals from incomplete teams (less than 5 athletes) can run in any race that they wish.
